The

- 1. Present only accurate and factual information.
- 2. Be prepared. Research and review your tour destinations, locations, stops, venues and activities.
- 3. Maintain and update your loose-leaf binder and files about selected tour destinations, venues and activities.
- 4. Dress and act in a professional manner. Be dependable and be early.
- 5. Think Interpretation. Demonstrate and compare. Relate to the senses: sight, touch, smell, hearing and taste.
- 6. Respect rules and regulations within public and Native American lands.
- 7. Know responsibilities of the tour guide, and the responsibilities of the motor coach driver.
- 8. Caution clients of dangers in desert and outdoors environment. Watch for warning signs of dehydration and stress in clients.
- 9. Maintain ethical standards of the Las Vegas Tourist Guides Guild.
- 10. Meet and exceed client expectations.
- 11. Be aware of your assignment. Check your paperwork if applicable and deliver what has been promised by your client or by you; follow directions if you are working for a DMC, meeting planner or another tour operator.
- 12. The tour is not about you, it is about your guest.
